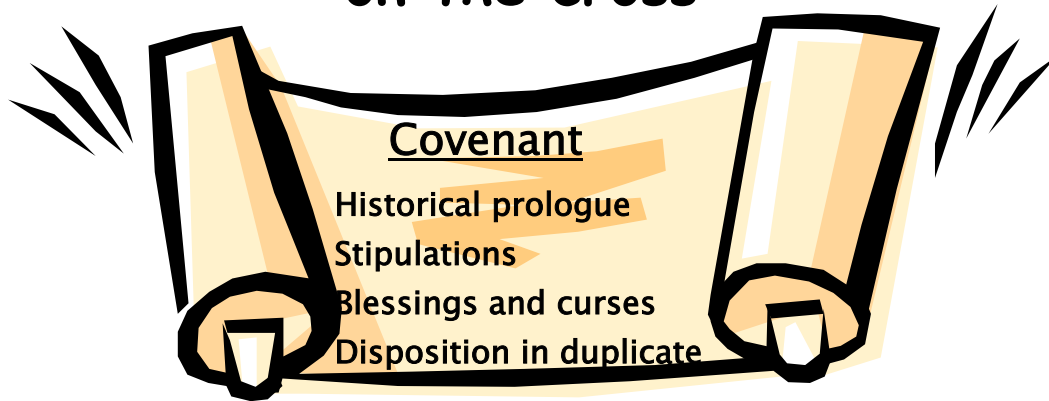




# Cross Purposes 1

In what ways does this account point forward to the cross?

- The place (v.2 cf. 2Chr.3:1)
- The means of death (v.6 cf. Jn.19:17)
- The provision of the substitute (v.8 cf. Jn.1:29)
- The cost of sacrifice (v.12 cf. Rom.8:32)
